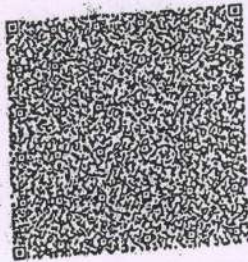

## TRUST DEED OF JAT SEWA SANGH

This Deed of Public Charitable Trust executed on this 12th day of May 2017 between Shri Yeshpal Singh Malik S/o Shri Ilam Singh R/o C-502, Doctor's Park, GH-5, Sector-5, Vasundhara-Ghaziabad (UP), hereinafter called the 'Settlor' (which expression shall, unless excluded by or repugnant to the context, be deemed to include his executors, administrators and representatives) of the one part, and

Hereinafter jointly referred to as 'trustees' (which expression shall, unless excluded by or repugnant to the context, be deemed to include the trustee or trustees for the time being of these presents and their successors in office) of the other part.

Whereas the Settler is desirous of establishing a trust for public charitable objects

And whereas the trustees have, at the request of the settler, agreed to act as the first trustees of these presents as testified by their being parties to and executing these presents.

And whereas it is necessary to declare the objects and terms of the public charitable trust, being constituted under these presents.

**NOW THIS INDENTURE WITNESSETH AS FOLLOWS:**

- (1) That, in order to effectuate his aforesaid desire, the settler has set apart and handed over to the trustees, a sum of Rs. 10,000 (hereinafter called the 'Trust Fund' which expression shall include cash and any other property or investments of any kind whatsoever into which the same or any part thereof might be converted, invested or varied from time to time or which may be acquired by the trustees or may come to their hands by virtue of these presents or by operation of law or otherwise howsoever in relation to these presents), and the trustees shall hold and stand possessed of the same upon the trust subject to the powers, provisions, agreements and declarations hereinafter contained.
- (2) That the name of the trust shall be JAT SEWA SANGH and its office shall, for the present, be situate at B-21 A (IInd Floor) Khasra No-572, Rajdhani (C) Park, 40ft Road, Mundka Nangloi, New Delhi-41 and/or at such other place or places as the trustees may decide from time to time to facilitate the functions of the trust globally.

**(3) THAT THE OBJECTS FOR WHICH THIS TRUST IS ESTABLISHED ARE:**

1. To promote educational development for upliftment of adults and children of all ages without any distinction of caste or religion and in the interest of mankind in general and to open schools, colleges, universities and institutions for providing education and imparting vocational training.
2. To promote and run coaching institute for competitive examination/ skill development centres / institutions for imparting training to the people of all ages in covering various areas of works so as to enable them to take up jobs for their survival and sustainability.

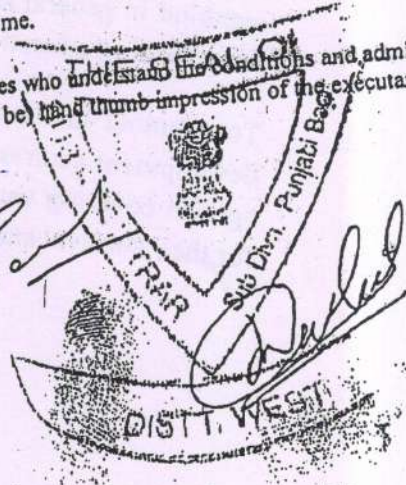

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3. To purchase land, building and to construct for setting up schools, colleges, training institution, coaching centers or take on lease, the schools / institutions / colleges already existing and being run by registered societies, corporates, state/central Govt. Departments, Govt. Bodies, Local Government, Trusts, Multi lateral agencies and individuals.
4. To promote, develop modern agriculture technologies by undertaking activities of research and development in co-operation with Governments, NGO's, farmers, education institutions, universities, multilateral and multinational agencies.
5. To promote and work for development and adoption of organic farming by farmers.
6. To undertake trading and marketing of agriculture produce and also to undertake setting up of cold chains, warehouses and logistics facilities for facilitating marketing of agriculture produce.
7. To develop and support in setting up of projects in the field of food processing including setting up of processing plants for milk and milk products.
8. To organise awareness and training programs for making farmers aware about the improved livestock (Animals) breeds.
9. To establish, maintain and run scholarships and render other kind of aid to students including supply of books, stipends, medals and other incentives to study, without any distinction as to caste, colour, race, creed or sex.
10. To promote, establish, support maintain or grant aid to institutions for the promotion of science, literature, music, drama and fine arts.
11. To grant relief and assistance to the needy victims during natural calamities such as famine, earth quake, flood, fire, pestilence, etc. and to give donations and other assistance to institutions, establishments or persons engaged in such relief work.
12. To establish, maintain or support a home or homes for widows, orphans, special centers for providing shelter and protection to women and children in distress;

13. To create and promote enlightened public opinion on various issues affecting the citizens of India;
14. To encourage conservation and protection of the environment including birds, animals and all species of plants and animals.
15. To engage and participate in issues related to the protection of environment, policy formation with regard soil and air.
16. To provide food, clothing and shelter to all those in need and provide pecuniary assistance to those unable to fend for themselves due to old age, disease or any physical or mental handicap.
17. To undertake, or assist in undertaking, projects like digging wells, providing drinking water facilities, fodder for cattle, grains, seeds, fertilizers and agricultural tools for farming.
18. To establish, maintain or support dharamshalas, rest-houses, convalescing homes, health and immunization camps, infirmaries, orphanages.
19. To support the initiative of any individual, group or organization in maintaining, improving and preservation of reservoirs, irrigation tanks, tube wells, recreation centers, parks, playgrounds for children, libraries, museums, art galleries, cultural centers.
20. To establish, takeover, run, maintain, homes, sanatoriums, medical camps, health education and family planning centers, children welfare centers, natural health centers, nutrition centers and any other institution or forum for preventive curative or primary health-care and treatment.
21. To establish, takeover, run, maintain a center or centers for senior citizens or retirement homes or old people homes with facilities for boarding, lodging, health-care, nutrition, recreation, etc, as may be necessary.
22. To construct low-cost buildings and houses for the poor, disadvantaged and those in distress, especially in the rural and /or urban slums or wherever found necessary.

23. To conduct and organize seminars, workshops, conferences, meetings, public lectures on the issues of public good and to enhance awareness among people about the issues of national interests.
24. To provide assistance to approved funding agencies in verification of financial statements and progress reports of the voluntary organizations, pertaining to the said development projects and programmes in India.
25. To pay all costs, charges and expenses incidental to the management, administration and execution of the objectives and powers herein contained.
26. To open and maintain account or accounts for the Trust in any scheduled bank/ cooperative bank or banks for keeping the moneys and to operate on the same or to authorize anyone or more to operate upon them.
27. To accept, in cash or kind, donations, gift, grants, contributions (as Corpus or otherwise) from individuals, corporate, firms, local bodies, state government, central government and multilateral agencies and to collect interest and other income of the Trust for being utilized for furtherance of the aims and objectives of the Trust.
28. To invest, dispose of, transfer and otherwise deal with monies, assets and properties, for the time being, of the Trust in such manner as the law permits and proper to do in carrying out the objects of the Trust.
29. To incur all expenses preliminary or incidental to the formation of the Trust and its registration and for management and administration of the same.
30. To do all such acts, deed and things and extend all such other assistance to the voluntary organizations as may be necessary and incidental to the attainment of aforesaid objects.
31. All activities financed from the funds shall be conducted in accordance with the ideals and objects as stated hereinabove and no discrimination should be made on grounds of religion, caste, creed, sex or political affiliation of the implementing agency or beneficiary.
32. To promote public opinion on various issue of social interest.

33. To conduct and carry out surveys by way of collection of information, interviews, opinion polls on the areas relating to education, social and economic development, employment/ unemployment, productivity (agriculture/ industrial/ service), business, political in urban and rural areas.
34. To create awareness about the dynamic socio-economic, educational and science and technological changes taking place in the global arena and prepare the people of all ages to face such challenges to their advantages and enable them in a manner so that they can sustain such changes and challenges and survive.

**(4) BOARD OF TRUSTEES:-**

There will be 15 (fifteen) trustees at the time of formation of the Trust including the settler of the trust. However subsequently there can be a maximum of 100 (one hundred) trustees including the 15 trustees at the time & formation of the trust. It is further clarified that the trustees shall have representatives from various states of country and this representative will not exceed 15 (fifteen) trustees from one state. Each trustee shall contribute minimum Rs. 11000/- (Eleven Thousand) at the time of being nominated/ appointed as trustee. The trustees shall be from different specialized fields of life except those, themselves or their family members holding any portfolio of political parties.

**(4.1):- Tenure of Trustees:-**

The tenure of trustees shall be minimum five years. One third of trustees shall be liable for retirement, in this order of seniority-based on their appointment/ nomination at the end of five years. Such trustees shall be eligible for reappointment subject to the rules and guidelines framed by the Board of Trustees from time to time. The Board of Trustees shall be at liberty to fix any term for a trustee beyond five years if they think fit unanimously.

**(4.2):- A person shall cease to be a Trustee either:**

- (i) If he without leave of absence does not attend three consecutive meetings of the Trustees or for one calendar year, whichever is longer, or
- (ii) If he is requested to resign by 2/3rd of Board of Trustees present in the meeting or he is found guilty of misconduct which may lead to his cessation on the Board.

## **(5) MANAGEMENT OF THE TRUST**

In order to manage the functions of the trust efficiently and effectively the trust will have an organizational structure as defined under Board of Trustees who shall be known as Board of Directors.

### **5.1:- Board of Directors:**

The constitution of the Board will be as under:

#### **a) Chairman: -**

Chairman of the Board of Directors shall be appointed by the Trustees by majority. The Chairman of the Board of Directors shall be called as the Chairman of the trust.

#### **b) Members of the Board of Directors: -**

All the trustees will be the member on the Board of Directors. They will be called as Directors of the Trust.

(5.2):- The trust shall be managed under the supervision of various management committees constituted by the Board of trustees for managing different projects/ assignments. These Management Committees shall be called Governing Councils. These Governing Councils shall be at three levels viz National, State and Districts. Accordingly they will be called as National Governing Council, State Governing Council and District Governing Council. The Board of Directors shall form further sub-committee or any other type of committee for special purposes. The members of these Councils/Committees/Sub Committees shall be required to contribute (donate) as may be decided by the Board of Directors.

#### **Constitution of Governing Councils:**

(5.3):- The rules and guidelines defining the role, duties, tenure and eligibility of the members of Governing Councils shall be framed and modified by the Board of Directors (Trustees) from time to time.

(5.4):- There will be a meeting of the Board each year within 60 days, after the closing of the financial year to finalize and adopt the annual accounts. The financial year will be from April 1st to March 31<sup>st</sup> or any other period in consonance with other existing directors or amendments in the statute.

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(5.5):- There will be quarterly meetings of the various committees as appointed by the Board both at National/State/District level. The minutes and action taken reports of these Committees/Councils shall be put up in the Board of Directors half yearly meeting for reporting/approval.

(5.6):- The Board of Directors may from time to time frame or amend rules for the conduct and regulations of the meetings of trustees or councils and committees:-

(a) 1/3<sup>rd</sup> of Trustees/Directors of the total Trustees/Directors shall form a quorum for a meeting of the Trustees/Directors.

(b) All matters shall be decided mutually by Trustees or in the absence of the consensus by way of majority opinion of those present in the meeting.

(c) Resolution passed without any meeting of the Trustees but by circulation thereof and evidenced in writing under the hands of 2/3<sup>rd</sup> of the trustees shall be as valid and effectual as a Resolution duly passed at a meeting of Trustees.

#### (6) POWER OF TRUSTEES/DIRECTORS

##### 6.1:- POWER TO DETERMINE ALL QUESTIONS OF DOUBT OR DIFFICULTY:-

(a) It shall be lawful for the Board of Directors to settle and determine all matters of interpretation of these presents as well as matters of difficulty, doubt or dispute and all questions arising in the course of or incidental to the administration management and execution of the trusts and powers of these presents and any such settlement or determination shall be valid, binding and conclusive and shall not be objected to or re-opened upon any ground whatsoever.

(b) The Trustees shall have the power to determine in case of doubt whether any moneys or property shall for the purpose of the charity be considered as capital or income and whether out of income or capital any expenses or outgoings ought to be paid or borne and every such determination shall be binding and conclusive provided that nothing contained shall be deemed to authorize the Trustees to spend the income or corpus of the Trust for any purpose not authorized by these presents.

##### 6.2:- POWER TO RECEIVE AND INVEST OF TRUST FUND :-

- a) To apply the whole or any part of the income of the trust, or the trust fund or accumulations thereto, to any one or more of the objects of the trust, as the Board of Governors may, in their discretion, deem fit from time to time.
- b) To convert and deal with the trust property and/or any investments for the time being.
- c) To invest the Trust Fund either for the purpose of purchase of immovable property or in shares, stock or debentures or other securities and investments, or in deposits with or loans to any company, bank, firm or any other person, and to alter, vary or transpose such investments, from time to time at the discretion of the Board of Governors.
- d) To start, abolish, discontinue and restart any charity or charitable institutions for the benefit of general public and to impose any conditions to any subscription or donation made by them.
- e) To set apart and/or allocate the whole or a part of the income or the corpus of the Trust Fund or part thereof for any of the objects of the Trust.
- f) To give aid by way of donations out of the income or the corpus of the Trust Fund or otherwise, to different charitable institutions, societies, organizations or Trusts in India which may have been established or which may hereafter be established for the like charitable purposes mentioned in these presents or any of them to enable such institution, societies, organization or the Board of Directors to start maintain, or carry out such charitable objects.

**6.3:- POWER TO APPOINT:-**

- (a) To appoint attorneys or agents and to delegate to such attorneys or agents all or any of the powers vested on them under these presents and from time to time remove such attorneys or agents and to appoint other or others in his or their place.
- (b) To appoint or make provision for the appointment of any person (including all or any of the Board of Directors and committees or administrator or otherwise) for the purpose of the administration of the Trust in such manner and subject to such rules and regulation as the Board of Directors may prescribe and also to appoint or provide for the appointment of separate Trustees to hold any fund or investment subject to the provisions of this Deed in such manner and subject to

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such rules and regulations as the Board of Directors may from time to time think fit.

**6.4:- POWER TO COMPROMISE:-**

The Board of Directors shall have full powers to settle compromise or compound, out of court, all suits, action and other proceedings and to settle all or other proceeding, difference of demand and adjust the settlement of all accounts relating thereto as fully as if they were absolutely entitled to the trust fund and without being answerable for the loss occasioned thereby.

- a) To adjust, settle, compromise, compound, refer to arbitration, all actions, suits, claims, demands and proceedings regarding the Trust Fund.

**6.5:- POWER TO PURCHASE, HIRE OR TAKE ON LEASE :-**

- a) The Board of Directors shall be entitled to purchase or hire or to take on lease a property or properties for the purpose of carrying out the objects of the Trust hereby created.

The Board of Directors hereby created can give any specific power to any Governing Council/Committee or create specific committee for that who will be liable to execute the same way as decision by Board of Directors.

- b) To sell, dispose of, alienate or otherwise deal with any property comprising the Trust Fund.
- c) To let out, demise any immovable property comprised in the Trust Fund for such period and at such rent on such terms and conditions as the Board of Directors in their discretion may think fit.

**6.6:- POWER TO BORROW:-**

The Board of Directors may from time to time, at their discretion for the furtherance and carrying out the objects of the Trust, to raised, borrow or secure the payment or to receive money as loan from any person, bank, financial institution or company whether with or without any security of the property of the trust.

- a) To accept any donation, contribution, grant or subscription in cash or in kind from any person(s), body of persons or trust, with or without conditions.

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- b) To borrow or raise or secure payments of moneys and also to lend money either with or without security.
- c) To apply to the Government, public bodies, urban, local, municipal, district and other bodies, corporation, companies, or persons for and to accept grant of money and of aid, donations, gifts, subscriptions, and other assistance with a view to promoting the objects of the Trust and to discuss and negotiate with the Government Departments, public and other bodies corporations, companies or persons, scheme and other work and matters within the objects of the Trust and to confirm to any proper condition upon which such grants and other payments may be made.

**6.7:- INVESTMENT OF TRUST FUND:-**

All money forming part of the Trust Fund and requiring investment shall be invested in any of the securities authorized by law for investment of Trust Funds which are permissible under section 11(5) of the Income Tax Act, 1961 or shall at their discretion sell and/or realize the same or any part thereof.

**6.8:- IN WHOSE NAME MONEY TO BE INVESTED:-**

All money forming part of the Trust Fund requiring investments shall be invested and the conveyance of assurance in respect of any immovable property/properties forming part of the Trust Fund shall be obtained in the name of Trust for time to time as decided by the Board of Directors.

**6.9:- OPENING BANK ACCOUNTS:-**

The Board of Directors of JAT SEWA SANGH may open any bank account or accounts with such scheduled bank/co-operative banks /nationalized bank as may from time to time be determined by the Board of Directors and shall forthwith pay or cause to be paid the rents, income, dividends and all other money forming part of the Trust Fund to be credit of any such account or accounts and such be operated upon by such of the Board of Directors or other persons as may from time to time be authorized to do so by a resolution of the Board of Directors.

- a) To open account in the name of the Trust, the Board of Directors and/or Institutions/entities run/ conducted by the Trust with a Bank or Banks to operate such account and to give instructions to the Bank and to provide for

opening and operation of such account by one or more of the Board of Directors or by an agent appointed by the Board of Directors.

**6.10:- ACCOUNTS AND AUDIT:-**

The Board of Directors shall maintain regular accounts of the Trust Funds and shall get the same duly audited by a firm of Chartered Accountants. The accounts and Audit Report and report of the Trust shall be made up at least once in a year covering the accounting period as may be determined by the Board of Directors from time to time.

**6.11:- POWER TO SELL THE IMMOVABLE PROPERTY AND MANAGE:-**

The Board of Directors shall have the power to buy, acquire, and take on lease any property, movable and immovable that may be needed to carry out and further the objects of the Trust and incur all such expenses connected therewith.

The Board of Directors shall manage any immovable properties for the time being forming part of the Trust Fund in such manner as they shall think fit with full power to make improvement, repairs or alterations of any description and to make or incur any outlay for any such purposes or for the insurance or otherwise for the protection of benefits of the said premises and to grant or renew leases or tenancy of occupation of benefits of the said premises and to grant or renew leases or tenancy of occupation and to make any agreements with tenants or occupiers or intending tenants or occupiers.

The Board of Directors shall, if the need arises, sell or assign or lease any movable or immovable property or properties for the time being forming part of the Trust Fund together or in parts for the purpose aforesaid or any of them to execute and do all such assurances, acts, suits and things as they shall think fit.

The Board of Directors may delegate their powers to manage the property to the respective Governing Councils.

**6.12:- RECEIPTS OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS:-**

The receipts in writing by the Trustee or any other person authorized by the Board of Directors for any interest, dividend or income of the Trust Fund or for any deeds, papers, writing documents or other monies and effect payable to the

Board of Directors shall be sufficient and effectual discharge for the same. The Board of Directors by a resolution may also authorize any scheduled bank or other banks in India to collect any interest, dividend or income of the Trust Fund on their behalf.

**6.13:- POWER TO AMEND THE RULES:-**

If in the opinion of the Board of Directors, circumstances so require, the Trustees may by majority make any amendment in the rules, they may consider necessary for the better management or administration of the Trust activities or for carrying out the objects of the Trust.

**6.14:- POWER TO MAKE RULES AND REGULATIONS:-**

In addition to the aforesaid rules, the Trustees, shall from time to time, be entitled to make rules and regulation for the administration and management of the Trust of these present and all matters incidental to or concerning the same provided, such rules and regulations shall not be repugnant to or be inconsistent with provisions of the purposes/ objects of the Trust thereof.

**6.15:- POWER TO AMALGAMATE OTHER TRUST OR VICE VERSA:-**

The Board of Directors shall be at liberty to allow or to be allowed and permit, or to be permitted to amalgamate or to be amalgamated with any other Trust, Institution or Charity, in any areas or area whose objects are the same or similar to those of these present, provided, they are not inconsistent with or repugnant to the objects hereof.

- a) To establish, promote, manage, organize or maintain or to assist in establishing, promoting, managing, organizing, or maintaining any branch of the Trust or any other Trust or its branch with objects similar to those of this Trust and to promote or carry on the affiliation or amalgamation of such other Trust with this Trust.
- b) To take over, acquire, manage, control or aid any existing institution or institutions having objects either wholly or in part similar to the objects of this Trust and on such terms and conditions as may be thought expedient.

**6.16:- INDEMNITY TO THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS ETC.:-**

The Board of Directors for the time being of these present, shall be chargeable only for such monies, stocks, funds deposits and securities as they shall

actually receive, notwithstanding their signing of any receipt for the sake of conformity and shall be answerable or accountable only of their own acts, receipts, neglects, defaults, and not for those of others or any banker, auctioneer or any other persons with whom or into whose hands any trust monies or securities may be deposited in accordance with these present nor for the determination or loss of any stocks, funds, deposits or securities not for any defects or insufficiency of title nor for any other losses unless the same shall happen through their own neglect or willful demeanors.

**6.17:- POWER TO REIMBURSE:-**

The Board of Directors of these present are entitled to be reimbursed and also to pay and discharge out of the Trust Fund, all expenses incurred by them or on their behalf in or about the execution of the Trusts and powers of these present in accordance with the decision of Board of Directors.

**6.18:- TRUST STAFF:-**

The Board of Directors may from time to time appoint one or more employees and servants as the trustees may deem expedient and fix their remuneration or Board of Directors can constitute a committee of specialized members for selection of staff and fix their remuneration & terms and conditions of services.

**6.19:- POWER TO RESIGN AND REMOVAL:-**

- (a) Every Trustee will be at liberty to resign on giving one month's notice of his intention to do so.
- (b) Any Trustee willing to join any political party to contest elections shall resign. In case he does not resign, he shall stand removed by the Board of Directors.
- (c) A Trustee may be removed from the office for misconduct or for obstruction of the functioning of the Trust by a resolution adopted by 2/3<sup>rd</sup> of the Trustees present and voting.

**6.19:- JURISDICTION:-**

The jurisdiction for any dispute shall be the courts of Delhi.

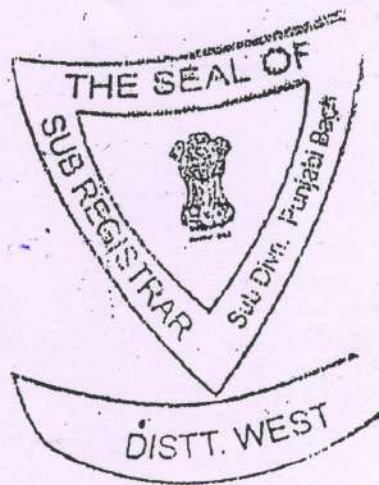
